Chairman Moore stated the purpose of the meeting was to discuss the 2019- 2020 millage rate and budget.

## **Discussion of 2019- 2020 Proposed Millage Rate:**

Chairman Moore stated the Destin Fire Control District, a state taxing authority, proposes a millage rate of 1.0000 which is 5.00% greater than the rolled-back rate of 0.9524 mills.

#### Adopt tentative millage rate:

Commissioner Green motioned to adopt a millage rate of 1.0000 which is 5.00% greater than the rolled-back rate of 0.9524 mills, seconded by Commissioner Wagner. With no further discussion motion approved unanimously.

## **Discuss 2019- 2020 Proposed Budget:**

Chairman Moore stated the Destin Fire Control District proposes a budget of \$9,177,469 for the 2019-2020 fiscal year, which is a 14.6% increase from last year's budget.

#### **Adopt Tentative Budget:**

Commissioner Wilson motioned to adopt the proposed budget of \$9,177,469 for the 2019-2020 fiscal year, based upon taxable value of real property totaling \$6,421,348,394. (6 billion, 4 hundred 21 million, 3 hundred 48 thousand, 394 dollars), seconded by Commissioner Wagner. With no further discussion motion approved unanimously.
